Remember to bring your book back if you've had one out this month. Also, please let **Susan Smith** know if there is a particular new book you would like to see us purchase

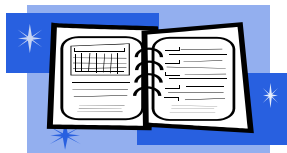


Sunshine/Shadows:

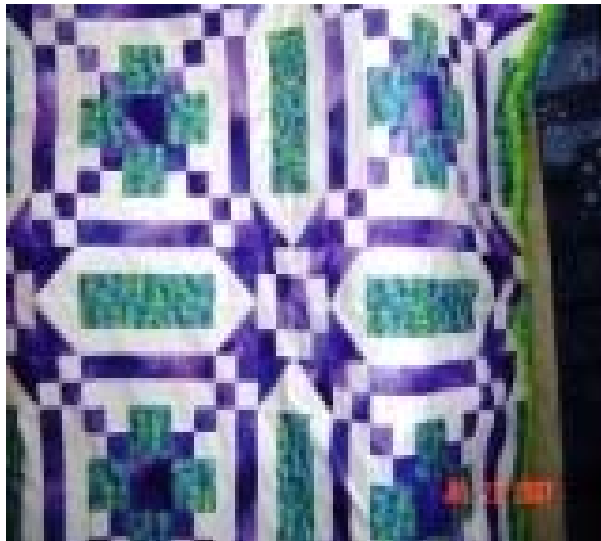
